Mary Greyeyes Reid was the first indigenous woman to join Canada's armed forces. She was born on November 14, 1920 and died March 31, 2011. Mary had six sisters and four brothers, one of which joined the military during the Second World War to help support the families' financial needs. Mary decided to join as well and following her brother's footsteps. As a result, she became the first native woman in the armed forces. Many of her superiors wanted to show the appearance of a pro diversity workplace, and they began to show her at public events. Mary had also met many significant public figures such as Queen Elisabeth II. RCMP officials saw Mary as someone who could encourage more women and indigenous people to join the Canadian armies. Mary symbolized the military's encouragement of recruiting women and native people in Canada.
