- ▶ She was an **American mathematician** whose calculations of orbital mechanics as a NASA employee were vital to the success of the U.S. crewed spaceflights.
- ▶ Her knowledge in mathematics helped **NASA** to send people to the moon and bring them back safely.
- ▶ She overcome obstacles related to **race and gender** as well, aiding in the great advancements of humanity.
- ▶ She was born in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia, on **August 26, 1918**.
- ▶ She was one of the first black students integrated into **West Virginia's** graduate schools.
- ▶ She contributed to plans for a **Mars mission**.
- ▶ She was given the **Presidential Medal of Freedom**.

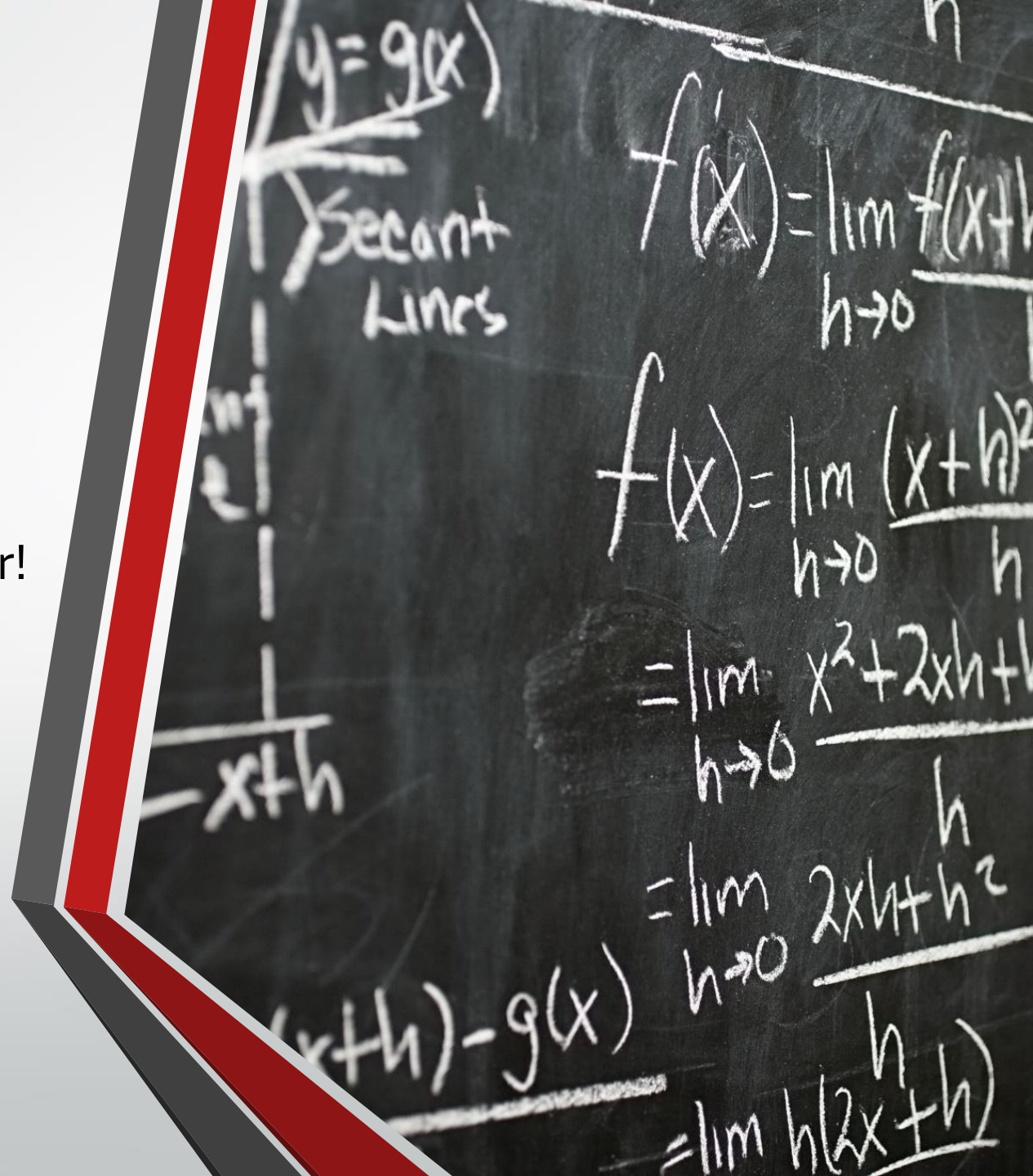

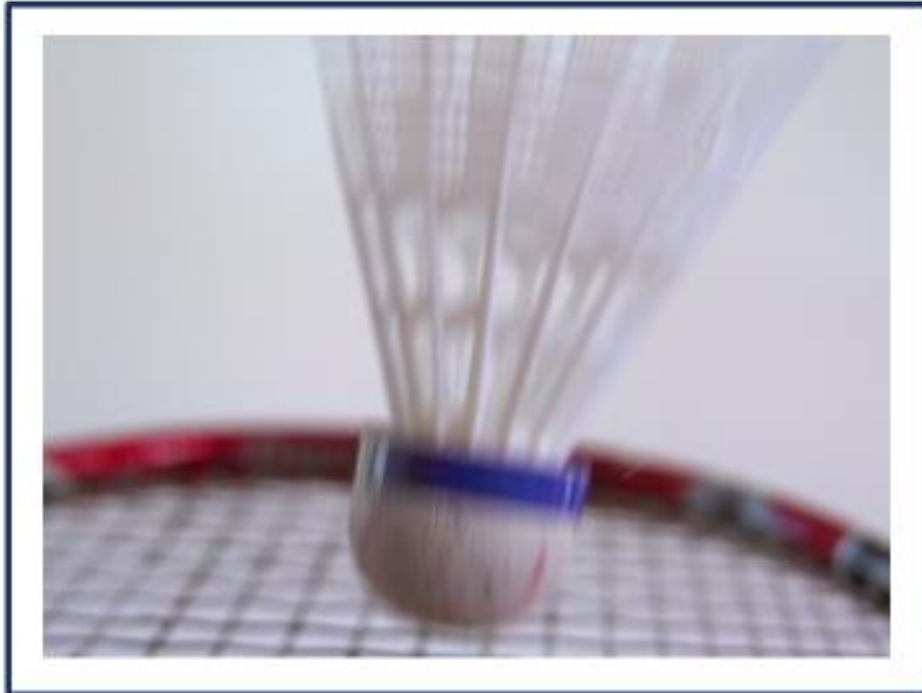

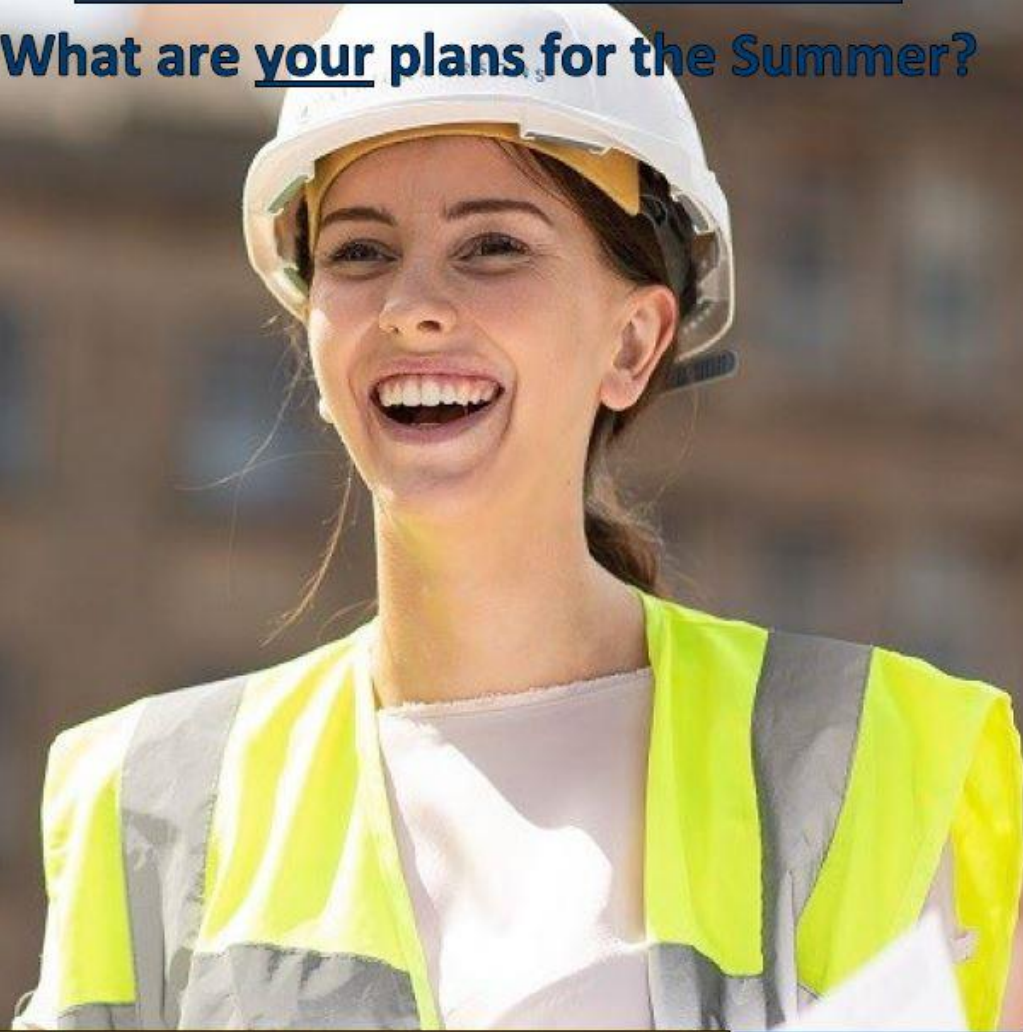
