

Organized by the Centre for Molecular Medicine and Therapeutics, the Gairdner High School Symposium is a half-day event held each fall that gives secondary students and teachers the opportunity to interact with Gairdner award-winning scientists and BC Children's Hospital researchers.

This event is scheduled for **Monday, October 21, 2024**. Grade 10-12 students can participate in-person or virtually in real-time.

Discovery Days in Health Sciences

Organized by the Canadian Medical Hall of Fame and hosted by BC Children's Hospital Research Institute, Discovery Days in Health Sciences is a one-day event that gives secondary school students and teachers the opportunity to explore a variety of career options in medicine and the health sciences. The day includes a dynamic keynote lecture, hands-on workshops, and a career panel discussion. Students gain a clear picture of what it would look like to be a health professional by interacting with researchers, clinicians and educators in their real-life work setting.
