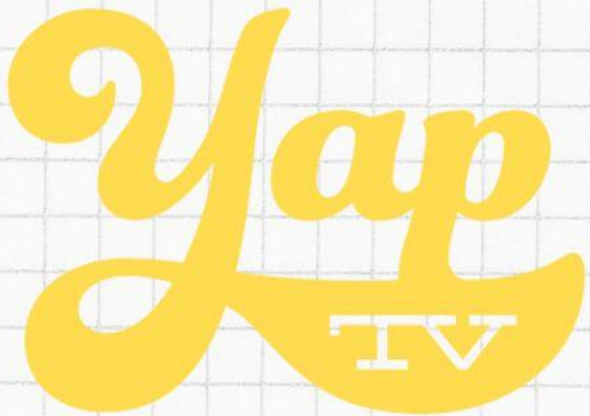

School District No. 43 is partnering with both Coquitlam Fire Rescue and Port Moody Fire Rescue to offer two different junior firefighting programs for 2025.

These programs are open to SD43 students in grades 11 and 12, and help applicants understand the basic physical and educational components required of new recruits in the fire service.

EDUCATIONAL COMPONENT

Tests knowledge of firefighting equipment and fire behavior

PRACTICAL COMPONENT

Tests endurance and teamwork skills
