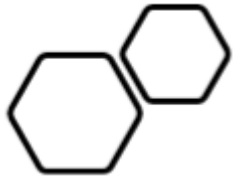

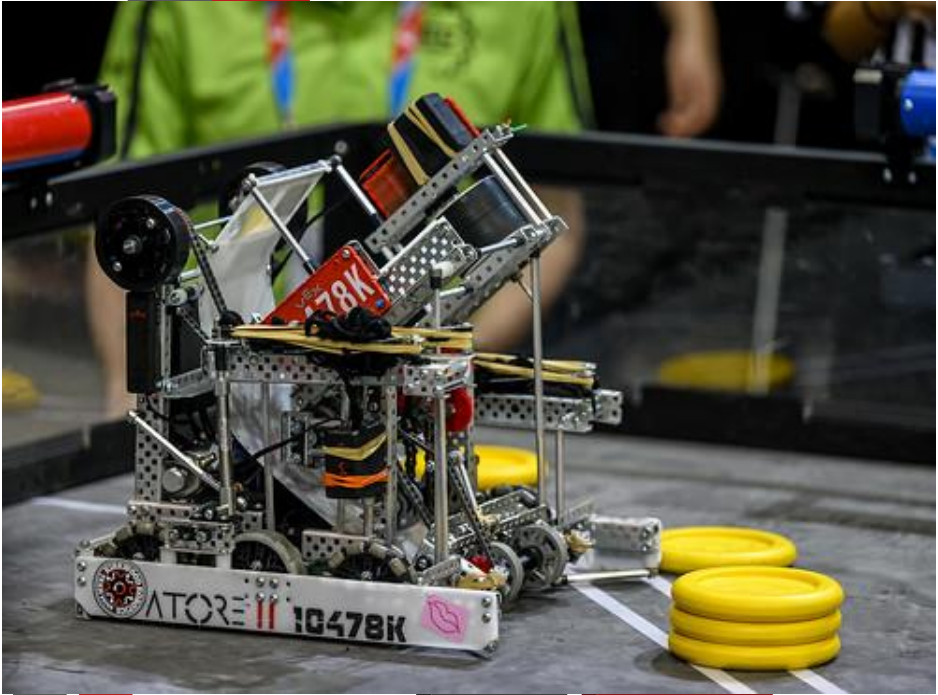


# SCHOLARSHIP MEETING FOR ALL GRADE 12 STUDENTS

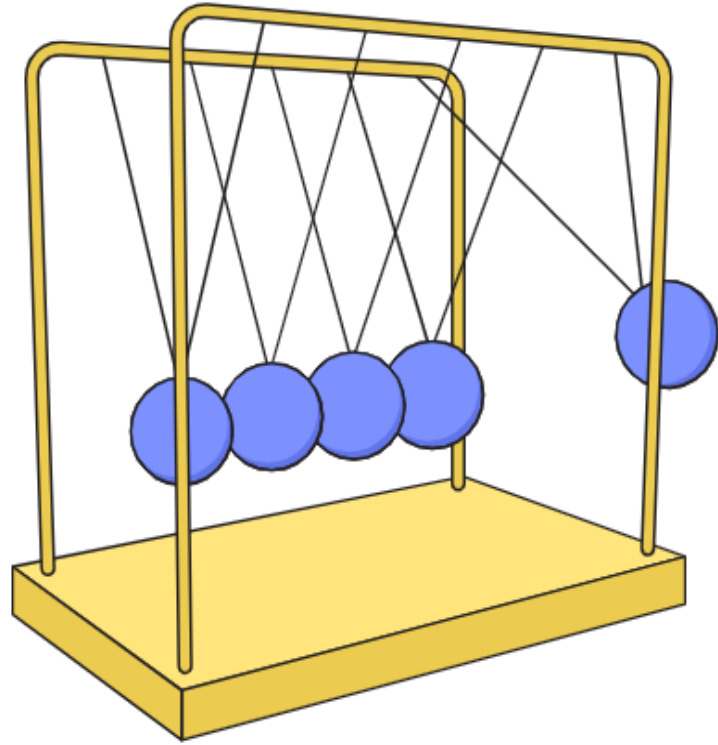
