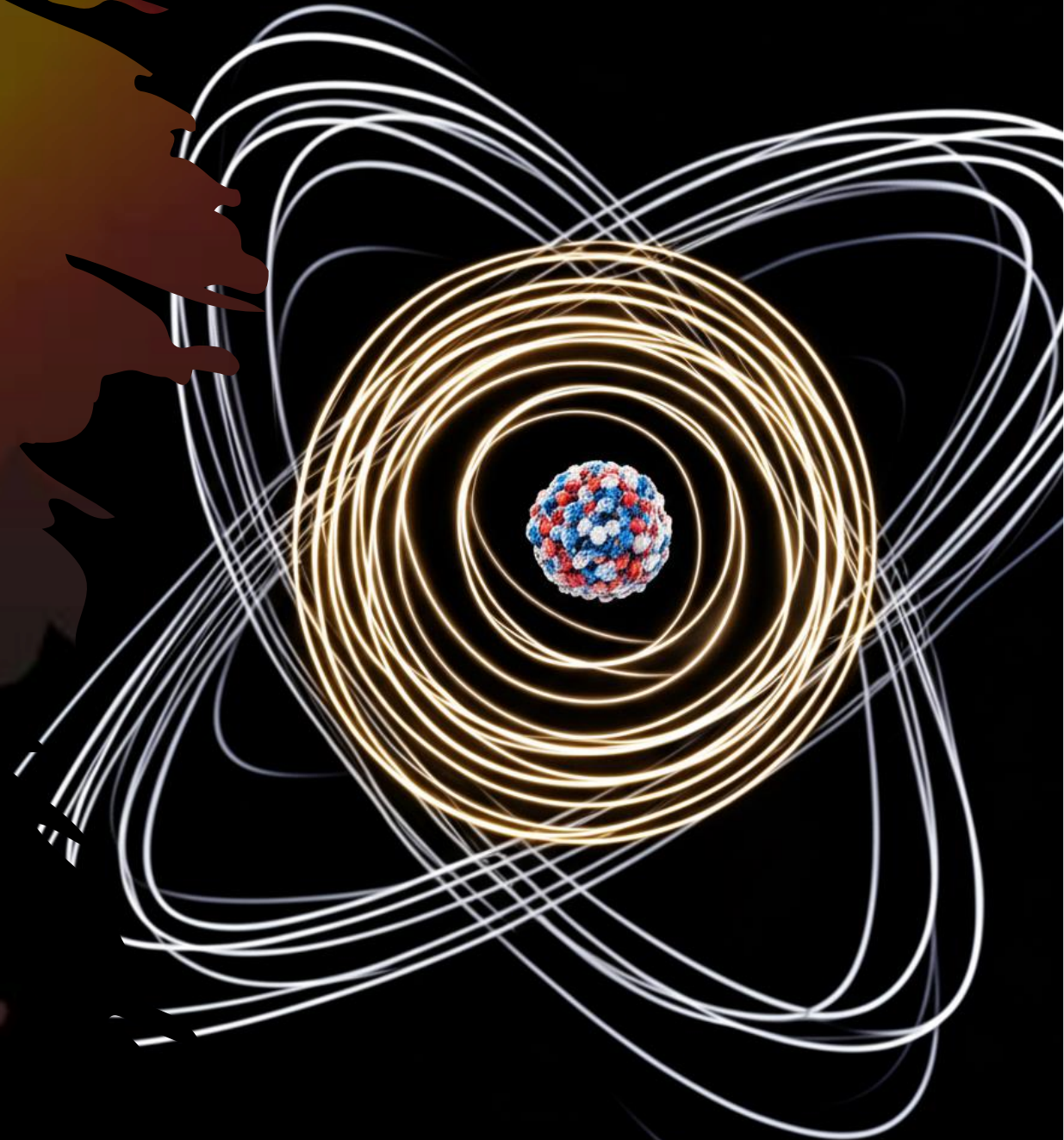

Carey Price is a Canadian professional ice hockey goaltender currently under contract with the Montreal Canadiens of the National Hockey League. Considered **one of the best goaltenders** in the world during his career, Price is the winningest goaltender in Canadiens history as of the 2023–24 season, with 361 career wins.

Carey Price, a highly decorated NHL goaltender, is of Indigenous heritage. His mother, Lynda Price, is the chief of the Ulkatcho First Nation. He grew up in Anahim Lake, B.C., where his family has deep roots within the Ulkatcho community. Price is known for his dedication to his Indigenous heritage and for being a positive role model for Indigenous youth.

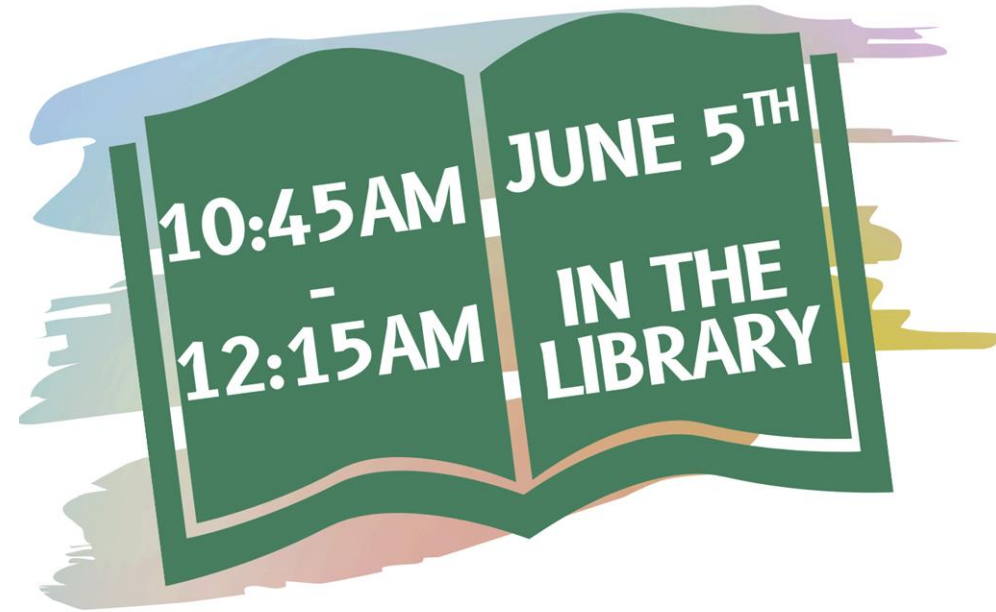

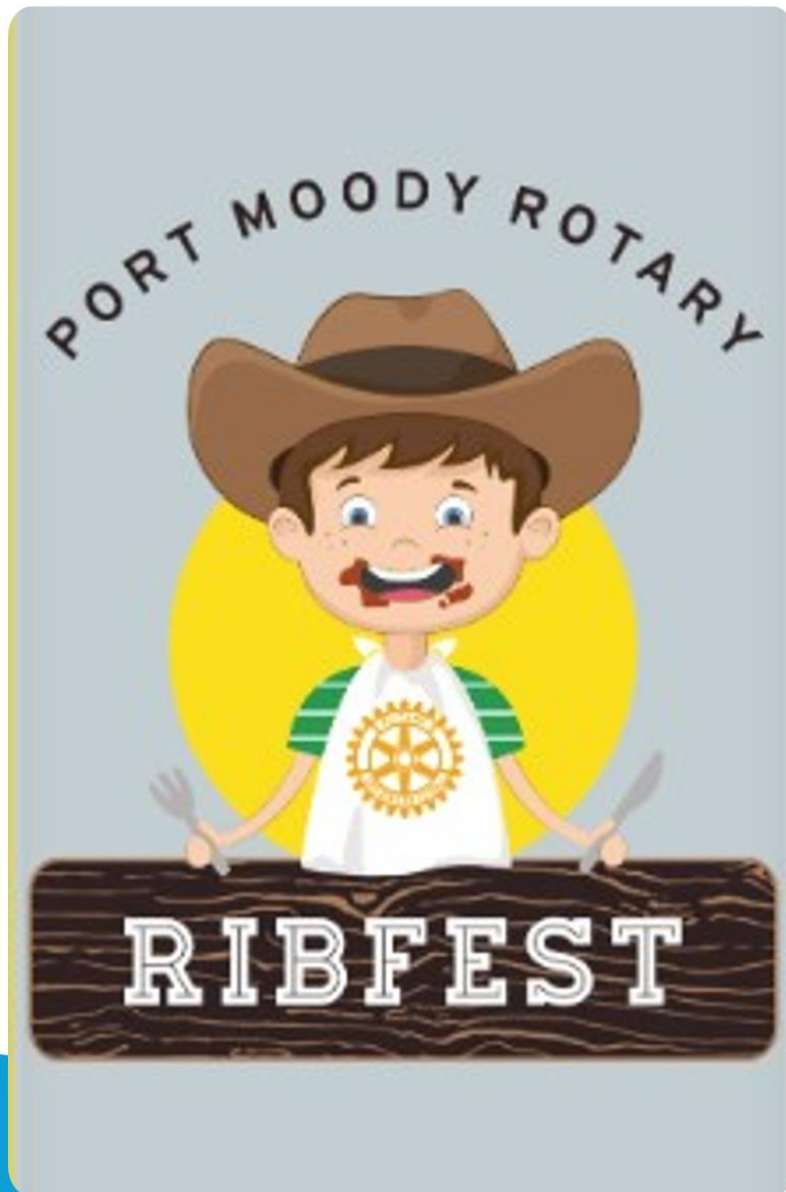
