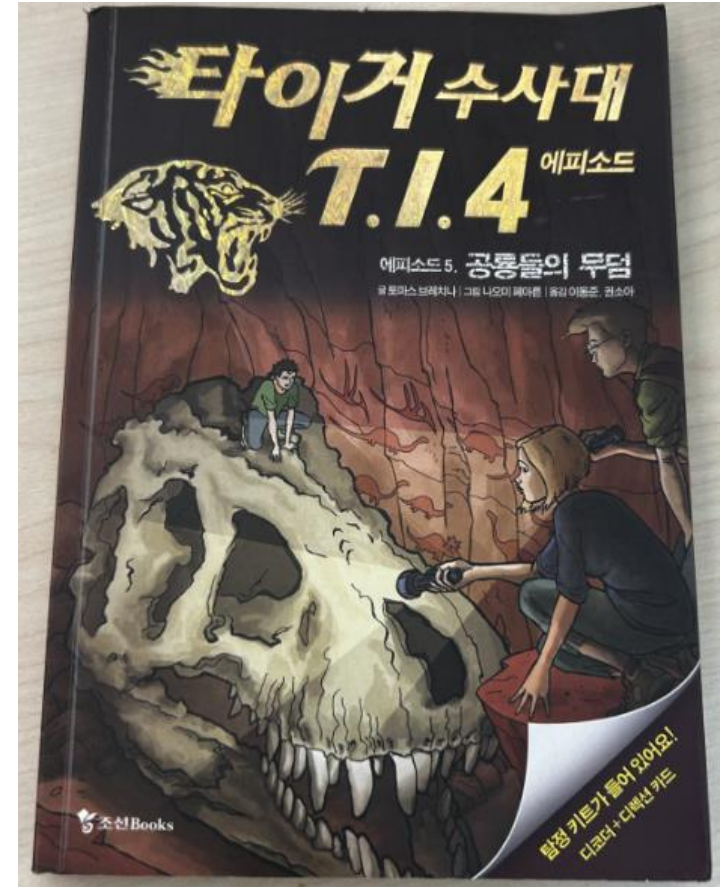

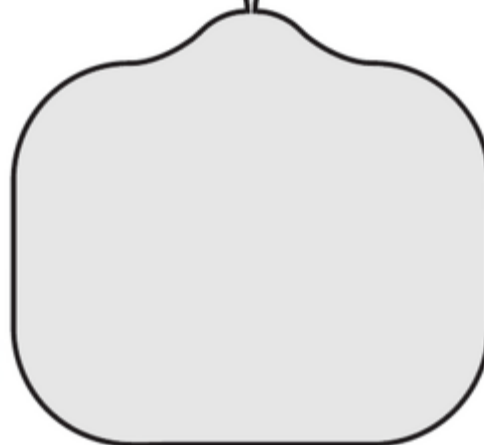
Celebrating Indigenous Brilliance

Science Spotlight



Dr. Nadine Caron (Ojibwe; Italian-Canadian)

- B.Sc. In Kinesiology (SFU) → first Indigenous grad UBC med school
- Master of Public Health (Harvard) → surgical residence (U of California) → Canada's first female Indigenous general surgeon
- Associate faculty at Johns Hopkins Center for American Indian Health; professor in UBC's Department of Surgery
- Leads initiatives to improve access to genomic research and healthcare in remote Indigenous communities
- Named UBC's inaugural First Nations Health Authority Chair in Cancer and Wellness (2020)
- Bridges Indigenous healing and Western medicine.
