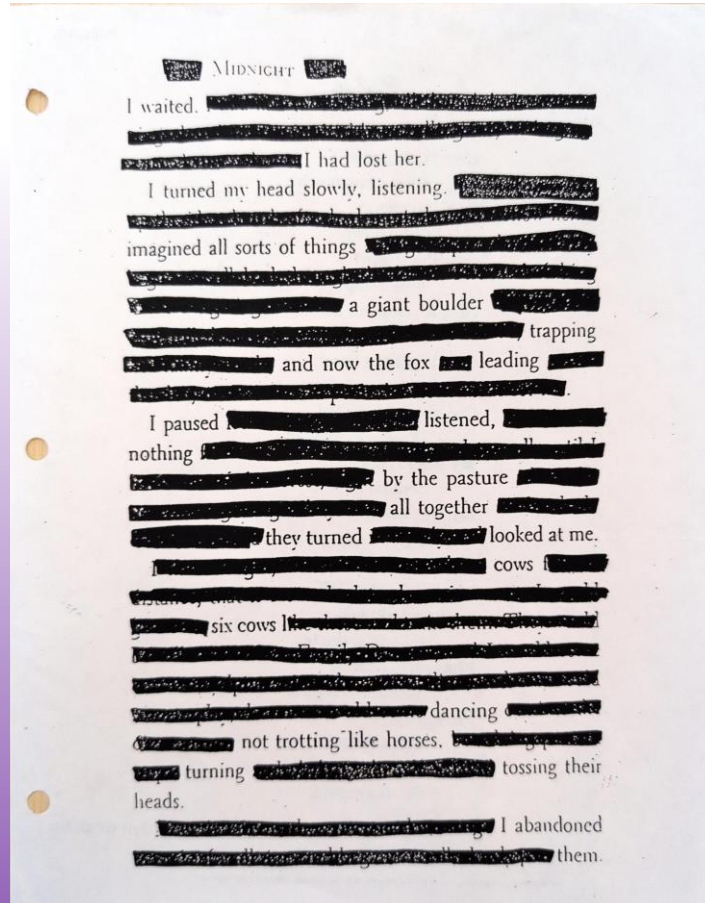

- **If your name is missing** → your portrait was not provided and will not be in the yearbook.
- Not for grad photos. Grade 12s must check spelling though – this is how your name will be printed.



Wrestling Team

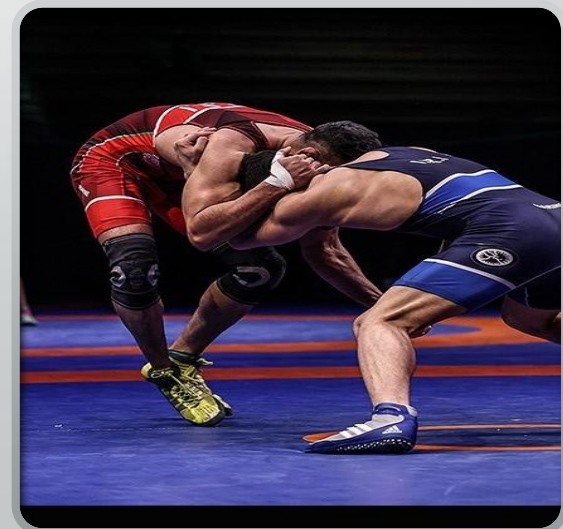

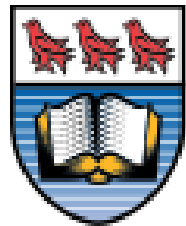
