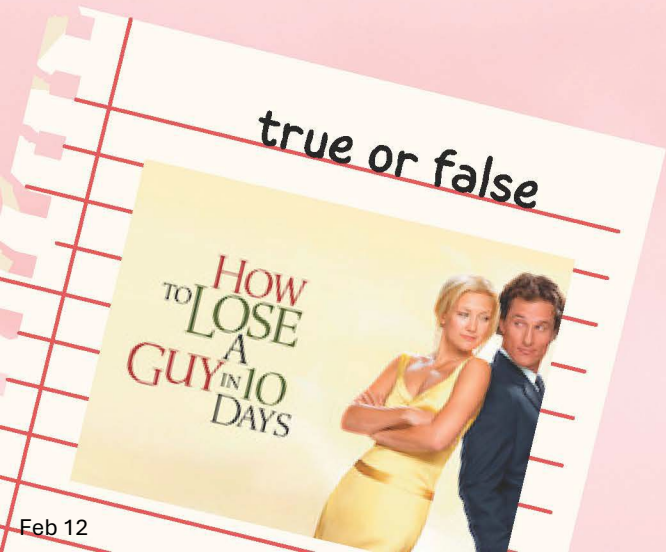

- Inspired by the Royal Military College (RMC) flag.
- It was chosen from over 3,500 proposals during an intense parliamentary debate, replacing the former Red Ensign.
