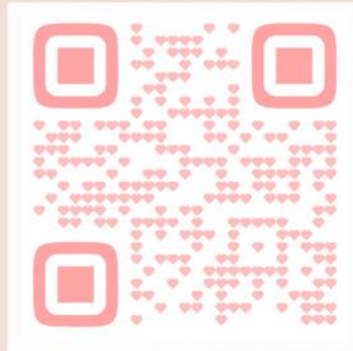

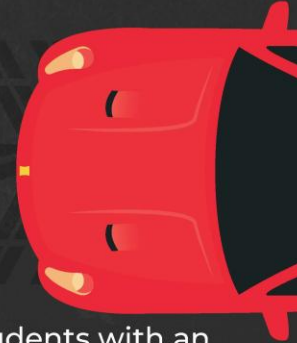

OFA Level 1 (Occupational First Aid) is a one-day, WorkSafeBC-recognized course focusing on basic, essential life-saving skills for low-risk workplaces. Participants who successfully complete the course will receive a 3 year certification.

TRAINING INCLUDES:

- ✓ Assess scene safety
- ✓ Perform CPR
- ✓ Use an AED
- ✓ Treat bleeding and wounds
- ✓ Handle minor burns

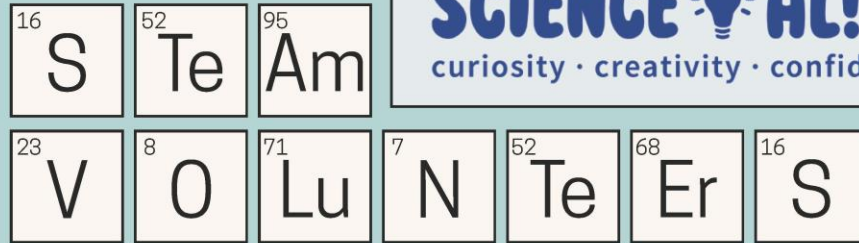
