# Heritage Moments

## Vimy Ridge Day April 9th

- After losses by the French, Canada defeated the German army at Vimy, France in three days (April 9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> 1917).
- Seen by many as Canada's symbolic birth or "growing up" as an independent fighting force (separate from the U.K.).
- Vancouver's own Seaforth Highlanders (Burrard Street) participated in the battle which saw heavy losses but successfully took the ridge.
- Today, look to your \$20.00 note to see the monument constructed at Vimy Ridge to commemorate those who fought and died.

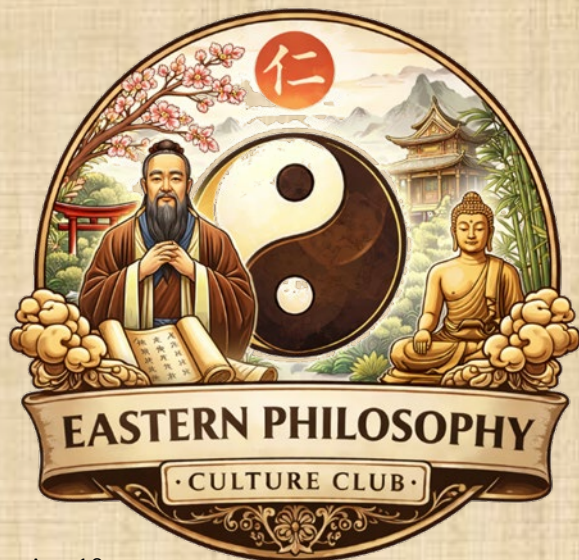
