# Song of a Blackbird

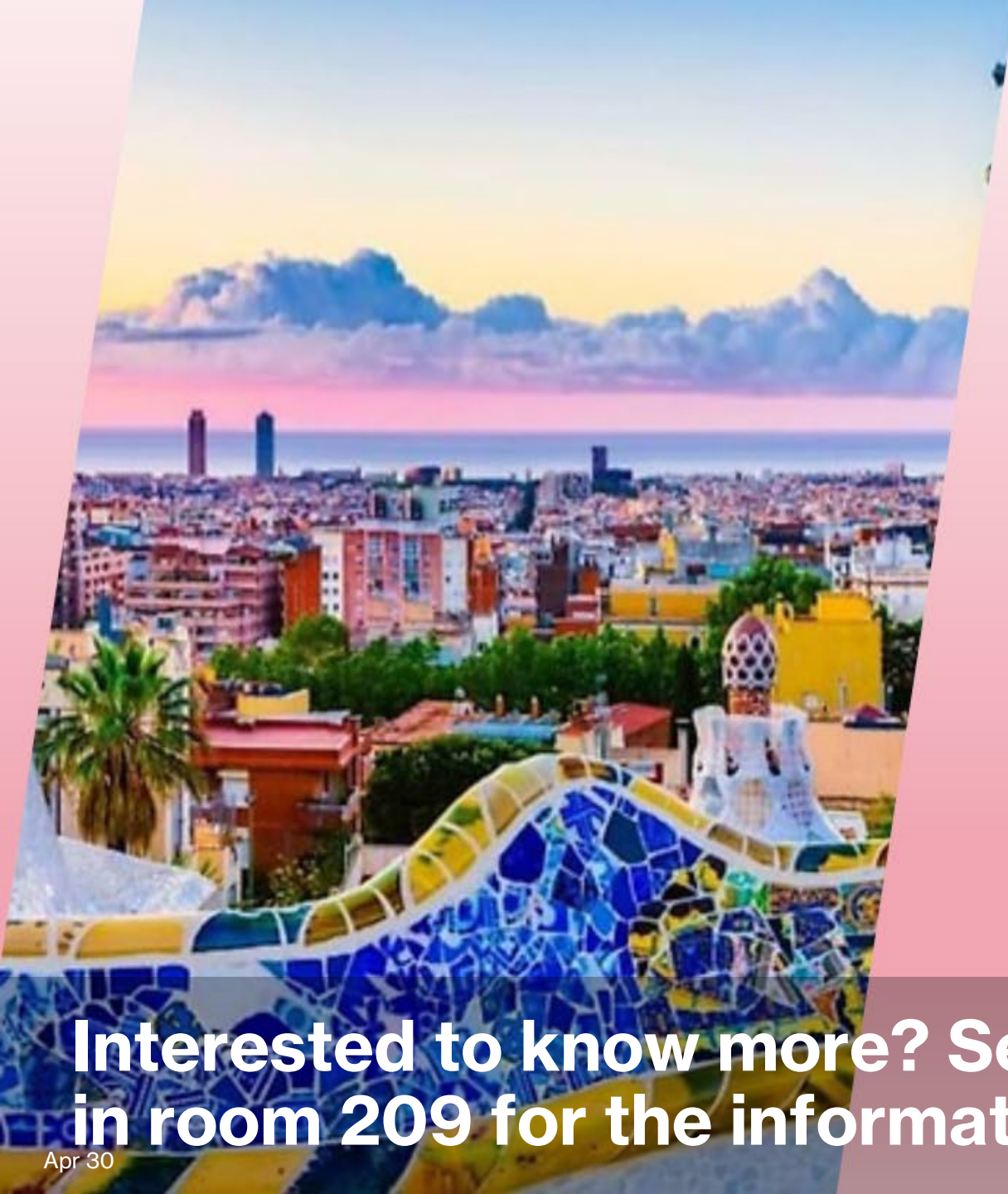
## Maria van Lieshout

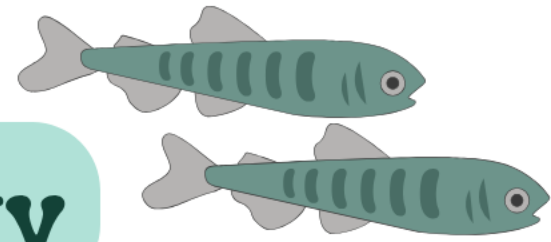

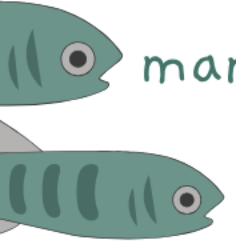

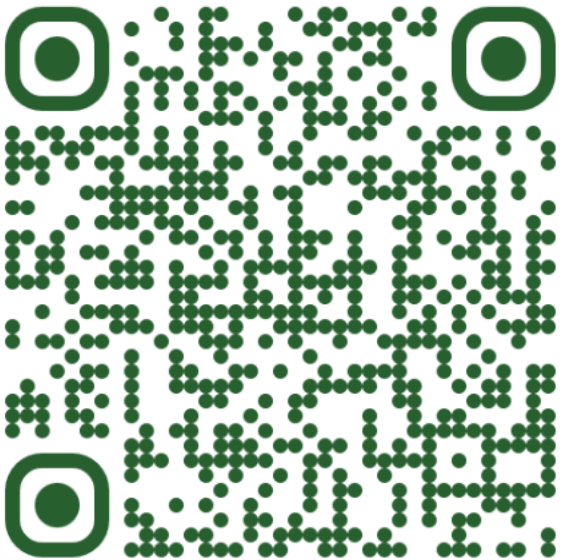
# Port Moody Ecological Society

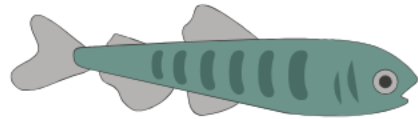

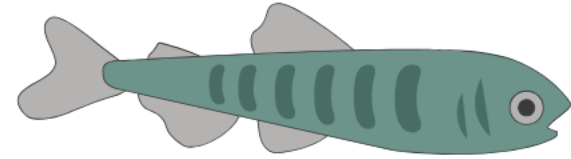
