INTERNAL AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS (Group 1)

These are School Based Awards where a Scholarship Committee select recipients of these awards. If you are applying for one or more, complete ONE application package only! You must indicate in the package which awards you are applying for. Return completed packages before the deadline to Ms. Butler in the Career Centre or Ms. Martin in the Counselling office.

EXTERNAL AWARDS, SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES (Group 2/3)

These are Sponsored Awards where the recipients are chosen directly by members of the Sponsoring Organization. There are separate applications for each award available in the career centre or online. Pay close attention to instructions regarding who this application goes to; whether your Career Counsellor, Counsellor or directly to the Sponsoring Organization. Also pay close attention to the application deadlines!

Check List:

1. **School-based Scholarship Application Form** (includes SIN, PEN & a Reference letter)
 - ✓ Your Reference must be someone who can verify at least one of the activities stated in your letter and/or on your Brag Sheet
2. **A letter about yourself:**
 - ✓ You and your personal goals
 - ✓ Why you think that you'd be a suitable candidate for the scholarship(s) you've indicated on the Application
3. **Brag Sheet** (if required)
4. **Financial Need Form** (ONLY if applicable - based on your parent/guardian's income)

RECEIVING AN AWARD

You will be notified in June.

REDEEMING YOUR AWARD

Your award letter(s) will have precise instructions on how to redeem your award. You must provide your award letter, proof of registration to a post-secondary institution, proof of payment in excess of scholarship amount and your SIN card or letter, in person, to the HWSS office or the School Board Office. Once processed, your cheque will be issued from the main School Board Office and will be mailed to the address you have provided on your award letter. (Allow 2-4 weeks)

These awards must be used within two years of receiving them unless otherwise noted.

DISTRICT AUTHORITY AWARDS are issued directly to you from The Ministry; usually in November by mail.

Send a card of thanks to the donor(s) of the award(s). Remember that we would like these donors to continue supporting students in the future and a letter of thanks will encourage this.
