► Students/caregivers are responsible for reading the course description booklet and choosing courses that will lead to graduation. - Only request **HONOURS COURSES** if you have received approval from your current coursework teacher.
- **ELL COURSES** - consult your ELL teacher about next ELL level or entry to English 10.
- **RESOURCE BLOCK - ONLY select** if you have been approved by a case manager or counsellor
- **CLC 12** – CLC is a required course for graduation. This is outside the timetable as a 9<sup>th</sup> course.
- **STUDY BLOCK** – applications will be available in Spring. You will need to select a full courseload for now.
- **EARLY GRAD** – if you are planning on graduating early, make an appointment with your counsellor. Select a full courseload for now.
- **MAKE SURE YOU HAVE 4 TOTAL GRADE 12** courses (English 12, CLC 12 and any other 2 from any year)
- This is a **REQUEST**. Every effort is made to accommodate; however, no request is guaranteed.
- Use the **NOTES FOR COUNSELLOR** section for additional information (see below)

Quick Graduation Checklist

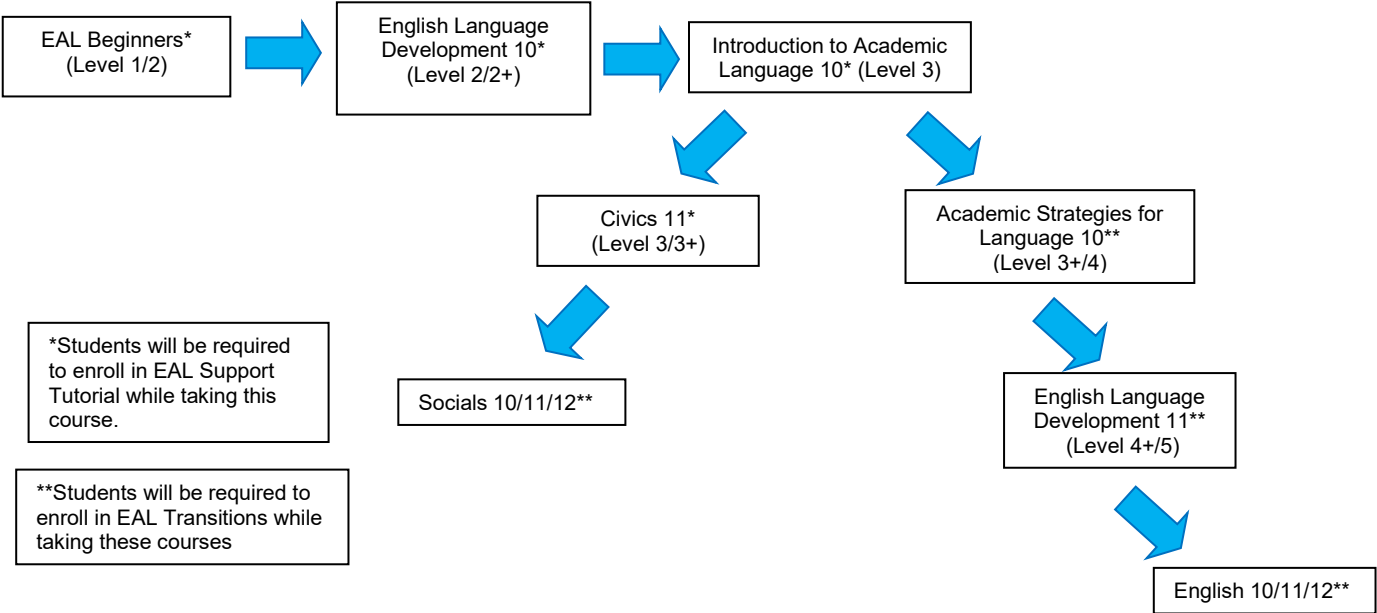
