Quick Graduation Checklist

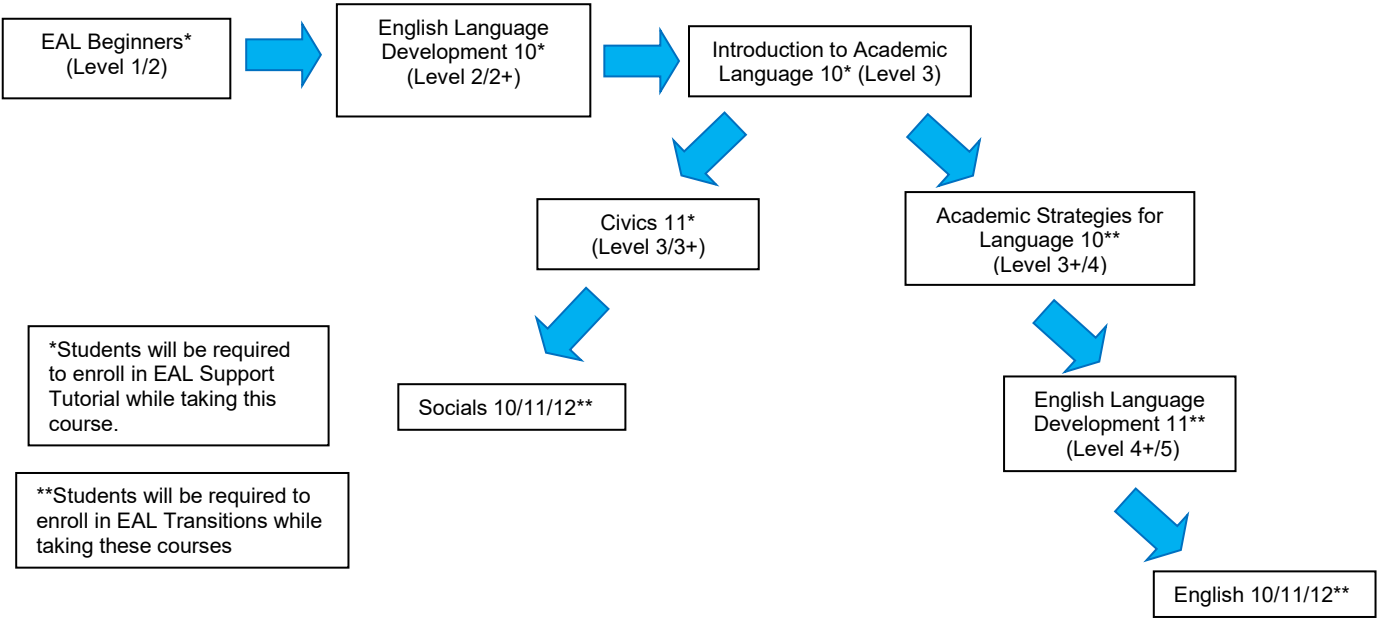
