- Students and families are responsible for choosing courses that will lead to graduation. - Only request **HONOURS COURSES** if you have received approval from your current coursework teacher
- **ELL COURSES** - students consult with their teacher about next EAL level or entry to English 10
- **RESOURCE BLOCK - ONLY** select if you have been approved by a case manager or counsellor
- **CLC** – CLC is a required course for graduation. This is outside the timetable as a 9th course.
- **STUDY BLOCK** – applications will be made available in the Spring. You will need to select a full courseload in the meantime.
- **EARLY GRAD** – if you are planning on graduating early, make an appointment with your counsellor
- **MAKE SURE YOU HAVE 4 TOTAL GRADE 12** courses (English 12, CLC 12 and any other 2 from any year) toward your graduation
- This is a **REQUEST**. Every effort is made to accommodate; however, no request is guaranteed.

Quick Graduation Checklist

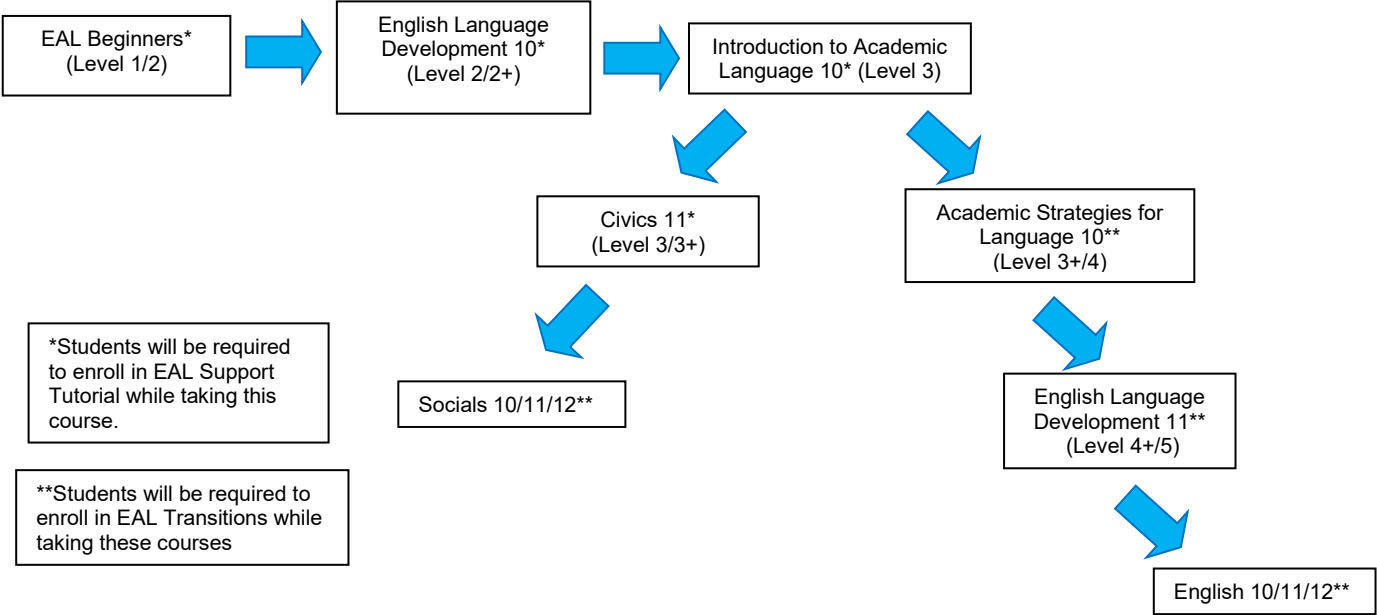
