## Quick Graduation Checklist for planning

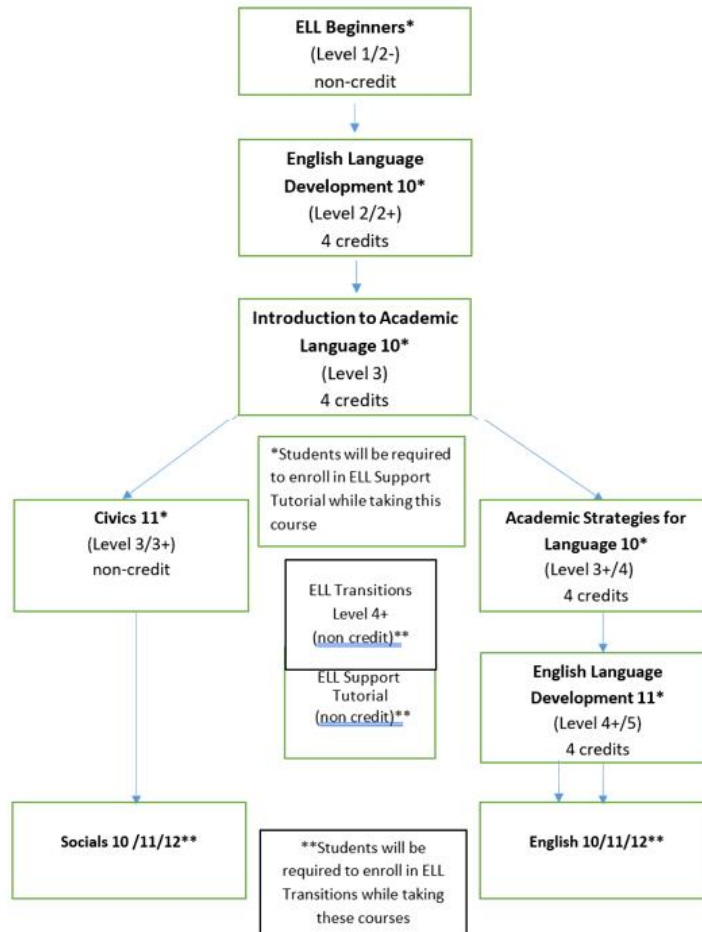
