For students in HWSS catchment, the portal will be open until February 23, 2023.

For students in district waiting for cross catchment approval, the HWSS request portal will be open to them once they are accepted into HWSS.

For students not in catchment, please complete the sheet and submit it to the front office and a counsellor will be able to input your requests.

- **This sheet is for your planning purposes only – for current GRADE 11 students**
- Students and families are responsible for choosing courses that will lead to graduation. If you have questions about the graduation program, refer to the Ministry of Education website: [Certificates of Graduation BC](#) If you have questions about courses or different streams, refer to the Course Request Booklet on the website under Course Programming: [Course Programming](#). **If you have further questions, contact your counsellor.**
- Only request **HONOURS COURSES** if you have received approval from your current coursework teacher
- **ELL COURSES** - students consult with their teacher about next EAL level or entry to English 10
- **RESOURCE BLOCK - ONLY** select if you have been approved by a case manager or counsellor
- **CLC** – CLC is a required course for graduation. This is outside the timetable as a 9th course.
- **STUDY BLOCK** – applications will be made available in the Spring. You will need to select a full courseload in the meantime.
- **EARLY GRAD** – if you are planning on graduating early, make an appointment with your counsellor
- **MAKE SURE YOU HAVE 4 TOTAL GRADE 12** courses (English 12, CLC 12 and any other 2 from any year) toward your graduation
- This is a **REQUEST**. Every effort is made to accommodate; however, no request is guaranteed.
- Use the **NOTES FOR COUNSELLOR** section for additional information (see below)

Quick Graduation Checklist

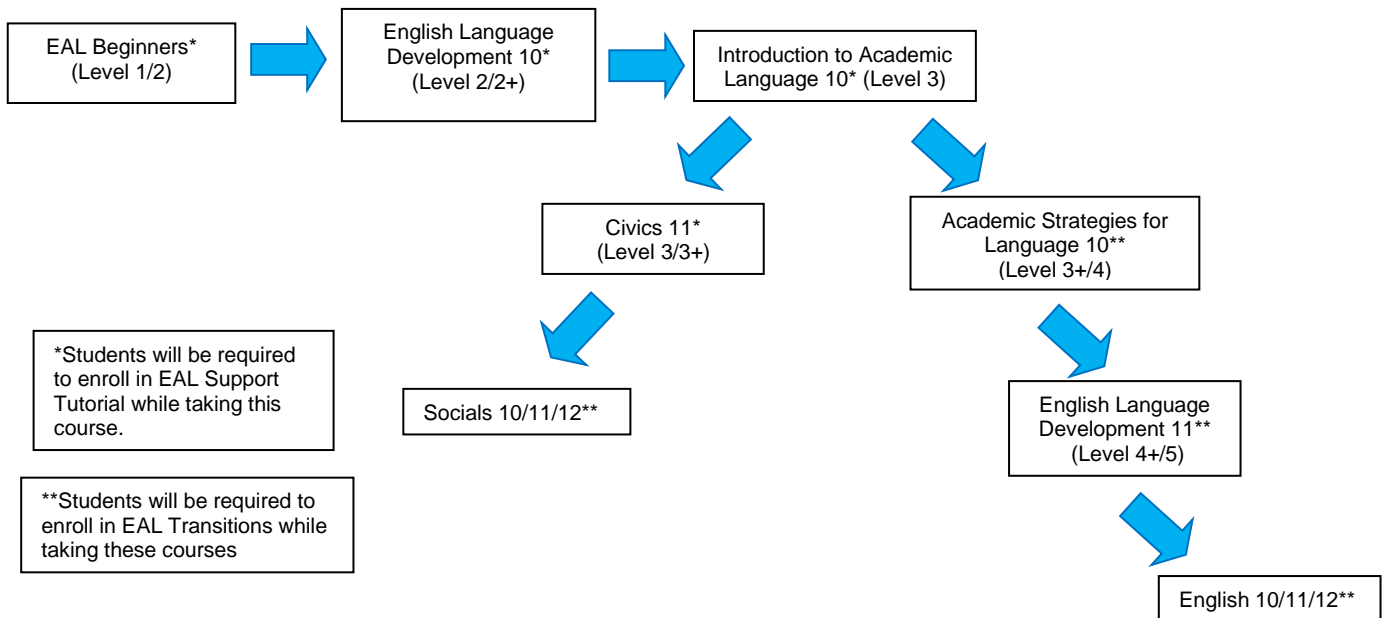
