  Students and families are responsible for choosing courses that will lead to graduation. If you have further questions, contact your counsellor.
- Only request HONOURS COURSES if you have received approval from your current coursework teacher
- ELL COURSES students consult with their teacher about next EAL level or entry to English 10
- **RESOURCE BLOCK ONLY** select if you have been approved by a case manager or counsellor
- **CLC** CLC is a required course for graduation. This is outside the timetable as a 9<sup>th</sup> course.
- STUDY BLOCK applications will be made available in the Spring. You will need to select a full courseload in the meantime.
- **EARLY GRAD** if you are planning on graduating early, make an appointment with your counsellor
- MAKE SURE YOU HAVE 4 TOTAL GRADE 12 courses (English 12, CLC 12 and any other 2 from any year) toward your graduation

### **Quick Graduation Checklist**


