We have set the date for the Math Accelerated Assessment for all students who were not eligible to write the one in January (due to cross-catchment process, new to the area, medical reason, etc). <u>This will take place at Heritage Woods</u> <u>Secondary on Thursday, March 30 at 2:30pm</u>. You are responsible for your own transportation to and from the examination. Meet in the Grand Hall outside the main office by 2:20pm. Someone from the Counselling Department will meet you and take you to the examination room promptly at 2:20pm.

You need to bring a pencil, eraser and calculator with you. The assessment includes basic topics from Math 8, new topics from Math 9 and problem solving. You are not expected to prepare for the assessment. It is designed to identify students who already have the required skills and knowledge to be successful in an accelerated course. Space in this course is limited to 30 students, and there are other opportunities to accelerate yourself (ie Summer Learning, Online). If accepted into this course, you should expect to spend a good amount of time completing daily assignments in order to be successful.

 Acceptance into the Mathematics 9 Accelerated Course is based on entrance exam & teacher recommendation. Math 10 Foundations & Pre-calculus credit will be given upon successful completion of this course.
