GRADE 8 STUDENTS 9:30 - 10:15

All Grade 8 students will meet in their new teams. Please refer to the map in this mailing for your child's team meeting place. Students will be ushered into their team's classroom area where they will do an ice breaker, have attendance, and be given some important notices to bring home. At this time, students will learn tentatively who their home room Core teacher will be.

Please note that the Grade 8s will begin at 9:30, a half hour later than the Grade 6s and 7s. Grade 8s who are arriving early will be asked to wait outside the school at their designated meeting place.

PARENTS are invited to the library/courtyard for coffee and refreshments from 9:00 - 10:15 am. This will be a great opportunity for you to meet some of our Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) members!

OPENING WEEK

Wednesday, September 5th will be your child's first full day of school for the year. Students will begin their day by reporting to their Core class "homeroom" where they finished up the previous day. On Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday activities will be planned to welcome students and orient your child to their team, core classes, and the general expectations. THE HILLCREST BUS: Bus service begins on Wednesday September 5th. The Coquitlam School District provides transportation by bus for students who live 3.2 km or more from the nearest elementary or middle school. These guidelines are established by the Ministry of Education. Only those Hillcrest Middle students who live east of the Lougheed Highway are officially eligible for bus transportation. However, Hillcrest Middle has also arranged for students who live closer than the 3.2 km boundary to ride the school bus as "courtesy riders". Courtesy riders may use the bus stops noted with an asterisk (*). Please note that courtesy riders will only be permitted to ride if there is enough space on the bus, therefore students should have a back-up plan. There are behavioural expectations regarding student conduct while waiting for and riding on the bus. The District Code of Conduct governs travel to and from school. Mr. Hewlett will meet with bus students during the first week of school and explain additional details.
