

Back to School Updates

Tuesday, September 8, 2015

- All students will check in at the gym
- Check in time for students in Gr. 1 to 5 will be at 8:45 am
- Check in time for incoming Kindergarten students will be at 10 am

(Accommodation will be made for families with children in K and Gr. 1 to 5 so that they can check in their children at 8:45 if more convenient.)

- Returning students will check in with their division from last year. Signs will be posted in the gym to identify divisions.
- Students new to Irvine will check in at the New Registration table in the gym and will be given a temporary assignment to a class until permanent class assignments are completed for the school year.
- Families who have ordered school supplies through Creative Children can pick up their supplies after student check in at the gym.

Wednesday, September 9, 2015

- Students in Gr. 1 to 5 are in session from 8:45 am to 2:43 pm
- Kindergarten students have been given gradual entry schedules for the first week of school
- Kindergarten families have signed up for 'Welcoming Conversations' with their kindergarten teacher
- Children do not need to bring their school supplies until directed by their teacher
- Students should come prepared for outdoor play at recess and at lunch

During the first few days of school, we will be confirming registrations, reviewing class size and composition. Once we have confirmed our organization plan with the district, we will assign students to their class for the school year. We will work as quickly as we can to ensure this is a speedy process.

Storm Clean Up
