## Activity Day / Terry Fox Run / District Terry Fox Run

On September 27<sup>th</sup>, we will be having our Activity Day (rain or shine) in the morning and our school Terry Fox Run in the afternoon. I am going to ask that you submit donations to your child's classroom and here's why: <u>we will continue to accept donations up to Oct. 10<sup>th</sup> (the day before the district Terry</u> <u>Fox Run) and the class that raises the most money will have three students randomly selected who</u> <u>will get to "pie me in the face!" This will take place at a later date in the gym during an</u> <u>assembly.</u>

On October 11<sup>th</sup>, we will be taking part in our District Terry Fox Run, entitled, "Running Terry's Money Home." A small number of grade five students will be able to take part in this (we'd love to have several students take part, but there will be hundreds of students from all over the district playing a role in this). Students that are selected will be running from our school to the Terry Fox Foundation Office on Shaughnessy Street (tentatively). Depending on the number of schools and students taking part, we may need to look at another location. More information will follow about the specifics of the district run (we will require some parent volunteers to assist us). All the money that is collected, will be pooled together (among all schools taking part) and will be presented to the Terry Fox Foundation in the form of a cheque. Last year, there were 15 schools that took part and we raised close to \$40,000! I'm told that 25 schools will be taking part this year, so we are looking for even bigger and better numbers. As mentioned above, donations are to be turned in to classroom teachers. We thank you in advance for your generosity.

#### Change to Student Accident Insurance

For some time now, School District 43 has been offering our families the opportunity to voluntarily purchase student accident insurance thru the Kids Plus Accident Insurance program, underwritten by Industrial Alliance Insurance and Financial Services Inc.

We were recently notified by the provider that they will be discontinuing the Kids Plus Accident Insurance program and will be replacing it with the Family Accident Reimbursement Plan. The new product is called Accifamily and offers comprehensive insurance coverage for the whole family.

The cost of this policy depends on whether you select Basic Coverage or Enhanced Coverage, as well as the number of family members to be covered.
