Kindergarten Registrations

Please keep in mind that Kindergarten registrations for September 2019 will be from Monday, February 4 to Wednesday, February 6. Each day, our office will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. for registration purposes. Feel free to share this information with a family who may not have access to this newsletter and has a Kindergarten-aged child. If you are planning to apply for cross-catchment to another school, please follow the process by applying to your neighborhood school first. The cross-catchment process starts at 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 7. You may apply via online or paper/hardcopy. Usually, online applications are much faster than paper registrations. The process closes on Wednesday, February 13 at 4:00 p.m.

Absences – Short Term and Extended

I recently requested via email to log absences via our website/email. Please use the 'Absence Report" link under 'Quick Links' on our school's website to log absences. I believe this will significantly reduce the number of phone calls in the morning and free up our secretary to look after students who arrive late.

Also, each year we are approached by parents who wish to take their child out of school for extended periods of time. Usually this is for reasons associated with family plans or family business. We do not have a procedure for granting students a "leave of absence". Rather it is assumed that parents will make decisions in the best interests of their own child. We are respectful of the fact that many of our families have family members far away, and spending time with them is important. Difficulties arise, however, when parents wish to have some sort of reassurance that their child will not be "behind" in their work when they return. If your child misses' school for extended periods of time, he or she will be behind in classroom work. Students may well have other cultural and travel experiences that contribute to their overall development, but the many varied daily classroom activities that they will miss cannot be duplicated through worksheets or workbooks. We are not in the position to provide assignments for children who have extended absences due to family plans. Rather we are providing a list of suggested activities that are designed to assist parents with planning for their child's educational needs while traveling. They are as follows:

- Set aside a time each day for reading books
- Have your child keep a reading response journal in which he or she records this activity and thoughts about what has been read that day
- Keep a scrapbook of special places or sightseeing
- Have your child keep a "math Journal" or ledger, dealing with changes in time and currency, distances traveled, cost of fuel and meals, etc.
