Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) for Grade 4s

Like last year, the FSA test for grade 4 students are at the beginning of the school year. Grade 4 teachers will administer the test during the month of October and the first week of November. The test will require students to complete literacy and numeracy tasks; most are paper-pencil tasks yet two parts are completed electronically online. Grade 4 parents can expect the results by the end of November. Please talk to your child's teacher or to me if you have any questions or concerns about the assessment.
