| 8 | Treasurer's Report (Katherine McGill) <br> - Current Account Totals <br> - General: \$1,227.38 <br> - Gaming: \$12.26 <br> - Playground Savings: \$79,610.17 <br> - 2022/23 Finances <br> - In June, the PAC executive bought gifts for JP staff members who were exceptionally helpful to us over the school year. We also bought a gift for our long-standing volunteer Lyndsay who was leaving PAC. We also contributed to the retirement gift of a JP staff member. These gifts totalled \$348.70. <br> - The Gaming Report for 2022/23 has been submitted. Gaming Grant funds for 2023/24 school year are expected to arrive in October. They should total around \$6000-7000. |  |

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| 11 | Playground (Katherine McGill ) <br> - Construction is currently underway and the playground should be ready for reopening during the week starting Sept. 25th. <br> - We need to make a plaque to fulfill our Tire Stewardship of BC (TSBC) grant requirements. <br> - Adjustments were made to the amount of rubber surfacing being installed in Phase 1. Originally, we planned to install all of the rubber surfacing needed for the entire project during Phase 1. We are now only installing the rubber surfacing required for Phase 1 components. In the future, more rubber surfacing will be required for the sensory path. <br> - We are currently short around $\$ 2,200$ for Phase 1, due in January 2024. We hope to fill this gap with donations from local businesses. At the next PAC meeting, the executive will present a new budget to allocate the needed funds for the playground project. <br> - Sarah will talk to some real estate developers about donating. <br> - Katherine has a donation package available for anyone who wants to approach a business for donations. <br> - Ribbon Cutting Ceremony will take place upon Phase 1 completion. We are trying to arrange a date between Sept.26-28. Habitat will be providing most of what we need for the ceremony. We will need to provide refreshments, and the cost of these will be under $\$ 150$. <br> - We will need a group of kids to take photos of on the ribbon cutting ceremony day. Parents need to be willing to sign press releases for these kids. Photos may be published in promotional material for TSBC. <br> Katherine will email interested parents once we know when construction will be complete. <br> - Interested parents: Luciana, Donna, Sonja (plus two of her friends potentially), Cynthia, and Courtney. |
