There has been some concern over the cost of this event. That alone brings you to $\$ 53$ for two children not to mention the crafts \& cookies the kids get to bring home, the movie rental and the gift from Santa. We feel you are getting good value for your money. As well, all the proceeds will get us closer to that new playground. We just want to remind everyone that $\$ 75,000$ is a lot of money to raise and all these events help get us closer to our goal. Your participation is extremely valuable to this playground project, as well as supporting the PAC budget.

In October, the PAC voted on a vendor for the new playground. However, due to pricing changes within the supplier's company, the cost went up. Therefore, we chose to do some further research and get more quotes on different products. We are excited to say that we are currently in the process of putting together a new option which would include a Grade 1 to 5 structure, with climbing wall as well as a separate Kindergarten structure for close to what our first option costs. Details will be available at the PAC Meeting/Social on December 1st at the Gillnetter Pub. We will be voting on the final structure and hope to begin the process of purchasing the equipment soon. Everyone is welcome to that meeting.

Although we are in a position to purchase the equipment, we still require at least $\$ 35,000$ for the site prep and install. Therefore, our fundraising efforts are extremely important in order for us to see this project through with a potential install of Spring 2009.
