## PLAYGROUND UPDATE

Very exciting news ... By now, most of you will have seen the initial ground breaking for our playground installation. We anticipate the playgrounds to be erected within the next few weeks! HOWEVER, although the structures are going up, we are still short on our installation funds by approximately \$14,000.

Kilmer families that still wish to donate would need to do so by **March 2^{nd}** (deadline extended) in order to have their family name included on our *Wall of Appreciation*. Donations will be accepted after this date, however, we will not be able to include your name on the *Wall of Appreciation*.

We are awaiting a response from BC Gaming & Enforcement on whether we qualify for up to \$20,000 of grant money. We hope to hear from them in March. However, we cannot rely on this as most of you know; in the past we have not been successful in receiving any grants.

We are extremely happy to announce another sponsor has generously donated \$5000 towards our project. A huge thank you to **Foresters Insurance** for their support!

Now for the fun stuff ...

We will be planning a **Ribbon Cutting Ceremony** immediately after the structure has been completed. This will involve some select sponsors and the Kilmer children. The date for this will be announced closer to completion.
