## CHAIR'S REPORT

The KPAC general meeting went well this past Monday and the committee formed last month reported that suggestions are coming in from parents for what to do with the KPAC's unallocated funds. Look for a survey to come out soon so that you can have your input if you haven't already.

Vehicle traffic and parking have been a challenge to manage at Kilmer Elementary for many years now, both in the morning and in the afternoon. The City of Port Coquitlam is making changes that will allow parking tickets to be issued to offenders if photographic evidence is presented to the bylaw enforcement office. Anyone in the Kilmer community, including school administrators, teachers, parents and homeowners, will be able to take pictures of violations and have tickets issued in accordance with the law. I truly hope that this will be unnecessary and that all Kilmer parents will show respect for homeowners in the area and for the students' safety.
