Yearend assembly- online

Due to gym capacity limits and concerns about large gatherings indoors, we are able to offer families the opportunity to watch our yearend assembly streamed live from the Kilmer gym on June 29th. *More details to follow.*

Grade 5 Leaving Assembly- in person

This event will occur shortly after the Yearend assembly. Parents of Grade 5 students will be able to attend in person (two people per student)*. Kilmer students in K to Gr. 4 will be able to watch the Gr. 5 assembly streamed live in their classrooms. * Please contact the office if circumstances cause you need more than 2 tickets

If your child has COVID-19:
If your child tested positive and are managing their illness at home, you can end isolation when all three of these conditions are met:

1. At least 5 days have passed since your symptoms started, or from test date if you did not have symptoms.
2. Fever has resolved without the use of fever-reducing medication, such as acetaminophen or ibuprofen.
3. Symptoms have improved.

If they still have symptoms:
They must continue to isolate for longer if they have a fever or are not feeling better. Presence of mild symptoms does not necessarily mean that you are contagious after 5 days. Most people recover within two weeks. Some people with more severe symptoms can take up to 12 weeks or more to feel entirely better.

If you are unsure or concerned, connect with your health care provider, call 8-1-1, or go to an Urgent and Primary Care Centre to be assessed.
