## PRNCIPAL'S MESSAGE

### Kindergarten Registration

Registration for incoming Kindergarten students officially runs from February 1st to 3<sup>rd</sup>. Registration forms a currently available on the district website. If a school is at capacity for Kindergarten intake, any registration received by February 4th at 4pm will be placed in a random draw for acceptance. Students who are not accepted will be placed in a nearby school with space. Siblings of current grades K-4 students get first priority in placement before a draw is initiated.

It is imperative that incoming K students with siblings currently in grades K-4 register before the February 3<sup>rd</sup> deadline. Failure to register by the deadline may mean that space will no longer be available for the incoming sibling.

Families who do not live in our school catchment area but have a child in K-4 attending our school, will register their incoming kindergarten student at Kilmer and do not register at their catchment school or complete the online cross catchment form on February 4th.

The program of Choice (French) application process has ended. Children who have been accepted into a Program of Choice register at the Program of Choice school. There is no need to register at their neighbourhood (English) catchment school.

#### **Cross Catchment**

Any student currently in grades K-5 who wish to attend another school in SD43 for the 2022-23 school year will need to apply for a cross catchment request. To appease an angry Th'owxiya, Kw'at'el embarks on a journey to find two children for the ogress to eat, or else! Students and staff enjoyed the traditional Coast Salish and Sto:lo music, masks, and imagery while learning how Raven (Sqeweqs), Bear (Spa:th), and Sasquatch (Sasq'ets) trick a hungry spirit

The funds for this and future opportunities have come from a donation of \$1,340.00 from BC Housing who have kindly supported our community's journey of engagement with Indigenous culture and knowledge.
