#### **SUN SAFETY**

#### Did you know?

- Children's skin can be burnt by sunlight, or by touching hot surfaces, such as pavement, metal slides, sand and car doors.
- Bad sunburns and too much time in the sun without skin protection have been linked with a higher rate of skin cancer later in life.
- UV reflection from sand, water, pavement, cement, and snow doubles the amount of UV exposure.

#### What Should Parents do?

- As much as possible stay indoors or in the shade during the hottest time of the day which is between 10 am and 2 pm.
- Gradually increase sun exposure from the beginning of spring/summer.
- Encourage children to drink plenty of fluids to replace body fluids lost due to heat.
- Check local radios/newspapers for the day's UV index. The higher the number the higher need for eye and skin protection.
- Apply sunscreen to children 6 months and older, with minimum of 15 SPF, 20 minutes before and every 2 hours during exposure covering all exposed areas including ears and lips. Wearing standard t-shirts only provides SPF of 6-8, so underneath needs to be covered with sunscreen as well.
- Sunglasses need to have both UVA and UVB protection and should be at least 80% protective.

School supply information for students heading to middle school will be sent to parents by their next school.




#### **2022/23 YEARBOOKS**
