CROSS CATCHMENT

Any student currently in grades K-5 who wish to attend another school in SD43 for the 2022-23 school year will need to apply for a cross catchment request. The online cross catchment process begins **TODAY** Friday, February 4th at 9am and ends on Wednesday, February 9th at 4pm. The parent/guardian must apply for a cross-catchment placement through the School District web site (<u>www.sd43.bc.ca</u>). Your student's PEN number is required to apply for cross catchment- you can locate your student's PEN on the top of their last report card. Check your catchment by visiting the <u>School Locator Tool.</u>

IF YOU HAVE COVID-19- updated Jan 24/21

Self-isolation and ending isolation

- Self-isolation essentially means keeping away from others to help stop the spread of COVID-19.
 Learn how to self-isolate
- Ending isolation if you are fully vaccinated OR less than 18 years of age
- Ending isolation if you are 18 years of age or older AND not fully vaccinated
- If you still have symptoms
- Ending isolation if you required hospitalization or if you are immunocompromised
- Ending isolation if you are a traveler

Please ensure you perform a <u>Daily Health Check</u> on your child before they arrive at school.

As the cases in our community rise, it is important that we all follow the directions from Public Health. 

CITY OF PORT COQUITLAM CELEBRATES MAY DAYS 2022 April 29 – May 7, 2022

Planning has begun for the 99th May Days festivities, and on behalf of both the May Days Committee and the City of Port Coquitlam, we are excited to share information regarding this year's festival!

Traditionally, the invitation for children to participate in the **Maypole Dances** or to apply to be in the May Days **Royal Party**, was distributed through the schools; however, due to the pandemic and Public Health Order (PHO) guidelines, May Days will look a little different this year.

In 2022, to simplify the process and support Port Coquitlam schools, the City will outreach to the community and offer online registration for the Maypole Dance and an online application process for the Royal Party.

Maypole Dances: This year, the Maypole Dances will be offered through a new Community Maypole Dance Program at the Port Coquitlam Community Centre. In order to participate, the City will open online registration <u>www.portcoquitlam.ca/register</u> (activity #64840) February 1st. Space is limited to 24 participants in Grades 3 to 5 who will attend Tues/Thur practices starting March 29th at the Port Coquitlam Community Maypole Dance will be performed during at the May Days Opening Ceremonies on April 29, 2022.

Royal Party: The Royal Party, which provides opportunities for children to perform in a dance performance at the Opening Ceremonies and develop community leadership skills, will continue with Flower Girls and Junior Lancers from Grades 1 and 2, and Princesses and Lancers from Grades 4 and 5. Members of the Royal Party will be randomly selected from interested applicants. The selected participants will be required to attend dance practices twice per week, leading up to the Opening Ceremonies on Friday, April 29, 2022. A more detailed list of Royal Party responsibilities will be provided upon selection of interested participants.
