# PICK UP AND DROP OFF SAFETY

If you live close by, we hope you will take advantage of the opportunity to walk to school. This is a great way to connect with your child and help them get off to a good start to the school day. If you are driving to school, please obey all street signs and respect our neighbour's driveways and property. The recommended drop off is on Knappen Street from the passenger side of the car directly onto our sidewalk. Please drive with caution through our school zone, especially during the first month of start-up. For pick-up please follow the same procedures to ensure clear crosswalk access and safe walkways for all of our children at the end of the day. The parking lot is for staff parking and handicapped parking only.

## **DRESSING FOR THE WEATHER**

Students will be going outside every day for recess and lunch. (Occasionally, we do keep the students inside under **extreme** weather conditions.) We ask that ALL students come to school with coats, appropriate outdoor shoes or boots, hats, umbrellas, gloves, etc. as needed. It is strongly **recommended** that students keep a change of clothes and underwear in their gym bags (older students) or in their indoor shoe bag (younger students).
