

Closure of Schools for Extreme Weather Conditions

In the case of extreme weather conditions such as ice, wind and/or excessive snowfall, the Superintendent of Schools has authority on behalf of the Board, to temporarily close a school. As a general expectation, parents should assume that schools are open. If parents believe the local conditions are unsafe, they should keep their child at home or arrange his/her early dismissal. If schools are to be closed before morning classes begin, an announcement will be made on local radio stations CKNW (980), CKWX (1130) and CBC (690) by 7:30 am if possible.



You must be a resident of Port Coquitlam to register, unless you are a returning player that has played box lacrosse for two or more years with PCMLA.

We no longer offer in person registration, everyone is encouraged to register online. In order to register online you must be in a position to pay by credit card.

If you can not pay by credit card please contact the registrar for assistance.

Sponsorship - Jumpstart/A4K/Kidsport

You must contact the registrar regarding online registration and advise of sponsorship information before your registration will be processed.

You are responsible for applying for subsidy through these programs if financial assistance is needed.

We will follow up to ensure you have applied. Failure to do so may affect a players ability to play.

'A' Team Tryouts - Novice Division Up

Athletes interested in playing on an 'A' team in 2020 will be required to pay a \$30 tryout fee.

At this time the fee is only for the boys divisions, however, if the girls division is tiered the same fee and procedure will apply and the fee will be collected at the first tryout session.

No player will be able to tryout for the 'A' division without this fee being paid first

Tryouts will begin mid February. Your division manager will contact you with more information closer to that time.

Tax Receipt

The confirmation email you receive after online registration is your tax receipt.

Be sure you keep it - no other receipts will be issued.

Jersey & Goalie Deposits

All players are required to supply us with a jersey deposit or goalie gear deposit.

Jersey deposits are \$100.00 and goalie gear deposits are \$1000.00.

Cheques provided must be post dated to August 1, 2020.

We will be diligent in ensuring we have these cheques prior to any games being played.

At the end of the season, once the jersey has been returned, we will destroy the deposit cheque.

First Time Players

The first time player discount applies to those registering to play lacrosse, box or field, with the PCMLA for the first time.

First time player registration fees are discounted to \$170.00. You will be required by the online system to pay the full fee for your division, and once registered we will initiate a refund for the difference.

First time players are required to follow up your registration with copies of player's birth certificate and proof of Port Coquitlam residency (ie a copy of hydro bill, cable bill, tax notice).

Your registration is not complete without these. They can be scanned and emailed to the registrar or post mailed.
