WINTER WEATHER EXPECTED

In the case of extreme weather conditions such as ice, wind and/or excessive snowfall, the Superintendent of Schools has authority on behalf of the Board, to temporarily close a school.



As a general expectation, parents should assume that schools are open. If parents believe the local conditions are unsafe, they should keep their child at home or arrange his/her early dismissal.

If schools are to be closed before morning classes begin, an announcement will be made on local radio stations CKNW (980), CKWX (1130) and CBC (690) by 7:30 am if possible.

VALENTINE'S DAY AT KILMER

On Friday, February 12th please wear Red, White or Purple!

As a result of COVID19 health restrictions, here is some information about Valentine's Day at Kilmer:



Food (Specifically Halloween, Valentine's Day and Birthdays):

- Events should not have sharing of food items, including families sending food for more than their child. Food of any kind, including individually packaged food brought from a child's home, should not be exchanged between students.
- Items that are individual wrapped and purchased by the school need to be distributed following guidelines set out for other food distribution programs.
- Even when eating candy, students need to wash hands before and after consumption.
- Schools are not to allow homemade food items to be made available to other students (e.g. birthday treats, bake sale items etc.)

• There is no evidence that COVID-19 is transmitted on textbooks, paper, or other paper-based products, however it is strongly recommended that card exchanges should be done electronically.

*More information may be coming out from classroom teachers regarding classroom events on February 12th.

ILLNESS POLICY

All students, staff and visitors must perform a $\underline{Daily Health Check}$ before coming to school and stay home when sick.

-Fever	-cough
-shortness of breath	-worsening of chronic cough
-vomiting	-loss of taste
-diarrhea	-loss of smell
-nausea	-chills

If symptoms do not improve or worsen after 24hrs you must seek a Health Assessment before returning to school.

A health assessment can include calling 8-1-1, a primary care provider like a physician or nurse practitioner, or going to a COVID-19 testing centre.

If a COVID-19 test is not recommended by the health assessment, your child can return to school when symptoms improve and they feel well enough. Testing may not be recommended if the assessment determines that the symptoms are due to

another cause (i.e. Not COVID-19).

If a COVID-19 test is recommended but is not done because the person or parent chooses not to have the test or a health assessment is not sought when recommended, and the person's symptoms are not related to a previously diagnosed health condition, they should stay home from school until 10 days after the onset of symptoms, and then may return if feeling well enough.

If the COVID-19 test is positive, the person should stay home until they are told by public health to end their self-isolation. In most cases this is 10 days after the onset of symptoms. Public health will contact everyone with a positive test.

If the COVID-19 test is negative, the person can return to school once symptoms have improved and they feel well enough. Symptoms of common respiratory illnesses can persist for a week or more. Re-testing is not needed unless the person develops a new illness. BCCDC has information on receiving negative test results.

If a child starts showing symptoms of which **could be Influenza or COVID-19** while at school, they will be instructed to put on a mask and moved to the Isolation Room. Parents will be contacted and must plan arrangements to have their student picked up right away.

Parents must seek a Health Assessment for their child, and students should not return for at least 24 hours.

KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION AND CROSS CATCHMENT TO MIDDLE SCHOOL

To apply for Kindergarten: School District No. 43 (Coquitlam) is pleased to welcome all new students to our schools. Children who are five years old on or before December 31, 2021 may enter school in September 2021. You may defer your child's enrollment until September 2022. Please contact your catchment school for more information.

Due to Covid-19, we have adjusted our Kindergarten Registration process. To ensure the safety of our students and staff, we ask that you do not visit schools directly to register unless you have made prior arrangements.

Registration Period: January 27, 2021 to February 4, 2021

Kindergarten Registration Packages will be available for download starting January 22nd. Please submit registration package ONLINE starting January 27th. <u>https://www.sd43.bc.ca/Schools/Pages/KindergartenRegistration.aspx#/=</u>

Families who applied for a Kindergarten Program of Choice will need to wait to see if they are placed in a Program of Choice before submitting a registration package. Families should only submit one registration package to their assigned Program of Choice school (if placed in a program) or their catchment school (if not placed in a program and waitlisted).

Apply <u>on the main page of the SD43 website</u>, starting Friday, February 5, 2021 at 9 a.m. to Wednesday, February 10, 2021 at 4 p.m. You will require your student's PEN number to apply for cross catchment. 
