The Fruit and Veggie Program started up again at Leigh on September 23rd. We are fortunate to be part of this free program which is part of ActNowBC, an initiative to improve the health of BC children and families. It provides two snacks per week, every second week. The snacks come pre-washed and ready to be handed out to the classes. Many of the items are also organic. Barring any crop problems, the schedule will include BC grown pears, plums, apples, carrots, oranges, mini cucumbers and grape tomatoes. The snacks will be eaten in class and are not meant to replace recess or lunch items sent from home. Permission forms MUST be sent back before a student is allowed to participate in the program. If you have not sent one back already, extras are available at the office or on the website, or you can send a signed and dated note to the office. ## **LPAC Fieldtrip Policy**

Last June the PAC voted to solicit donations of \$15 per child at the start of this school year to be put towards fieldtrips.
