- iii. Principal Report** Need a bit more information from Remi on numbers
 - **a. Kindergarten visit** June 17th 9:15-10:15 have tour for kids and parents. Invite members of the PAC to talk about PAC and give information
 - b. **5 600/less per student than average (50 out of ___)** the numbers are skewed by some high cost areas. Currently we get 6___/student. This district was second lowest on funding. Shortage of ___Million. Lost 1 role in the office (Ms. Marks) and student teachers and 150 positions in the district, reduction in support positions. All student services are reduced (2 ½ days/week less), able to do less assessments etc. Some teachers positions will be eliminated at the end of the year. What can we do? Write to your MLA to increase funding and increase staffing. Could look at DPAC website but they encourage the same thing: MLA. Go to the DPAC meeting in September (or at least we send a Leigh PAC rep).
