Good Evening LBP Families,

I hope you are all doing well and that your lawns and gardens are starting to take shape for the new season. Ms. Maller shared a document from Facebook with the staff that is worth passing along. There are three simple messages:

- 1. Children need a minimum of 8 touches during a day to feel connected to a parent. If there is a particular challenging time, it's a minimum of 12 a day. It could be as simple as the straightening of a collar, a pat on the shoulder or a simple hug.
- 2. Each day, children need one meaningful eye-to-eye conversation with a parent.
- 3. There are 9 minutes during the day that have the greatest impact on a child:
 - The first 3 minutes after they wake up
 - The 3 minutes after they come home from school
 - The last 3 minutes of the day before they go to bed

This was a great reminder to slow down and appreciate the great things in our life.


