Location: Domino's Pizza at 1206 Austin Ave, Coquitlam

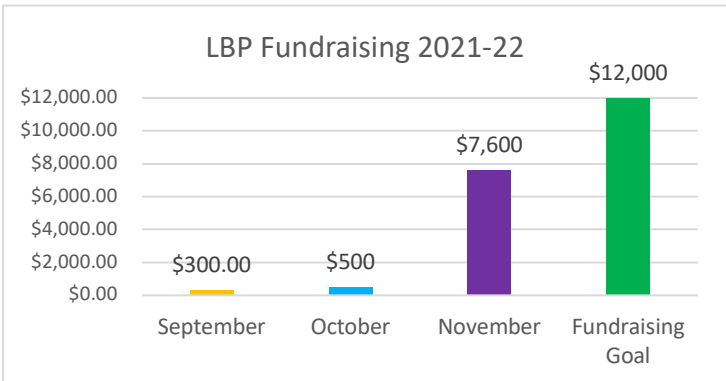
