Dear Parents and Guardians:

The year is quickly coming to an end and these last weeks of school before the holidays will be busy.

This is the season of giving and we just hosted our third annual staff and parent volleyball game in the gym this past Thursday, December 4. This event is held in honor of the late Mrs. Fagrie, a former LBP parent who was a big supporter of the local food bank as well. We are grateful to Ms Barnett and her class for the organizational efforts, to the parents and staff members who participated in this highly entertaining game, and we THANK YOU for supporting this event and our food drive.

In addition, the Me to We Club will also be sponsoring another food drive next week Thursday. On Thursday, Dec. 11 students can exchange a non-perishable food item for a cupcake. We have asked Div. 4, 5 and 6 students to bring the cupcakes and we are hoping to collect a good number of food items on that day as well. Students can also purchase a hot chocolate at lunch time for 50 cents. Food donations can be made until Thursday, December 18.

Staff and students have been working very hard to get everyone ready for our Christmas concerts on Wed Dec. 17 (6:30 p.m.) and Thurs Dec. 18 (1:15 p.m.). I hope we will be able to see you then!

Similar to last year, you will be able to buy raffle tickets for the principal's parking spot as well as front row seats AND seats on a couch during the Christmas Concert itself. Raffle ticket prices are \$2 for one and \$5 for 3 tickets. To increase the number of winning raffle tickets, front row chairs will



also be raffled off. The money made from the fundraiser will go towards LBP's annual pancake breakfast. Tickets are available at the office and will be on sale until Tuesday, Dec. 16.

By now, you also should have received a notice regarding the tradition of our pancake breakfast. This year's breakfast will be on Friday, December 19. Thank you so much to those parents who have put their names forward to volunteer cooking pancakes that morning. Similar to last year, we will be asking students for a suggested donation of \$2 to help offset some of the costs for the breakfast. To cut down on the amount of garbage an event such as this can produce, we are asking every child to bring a plastic plate, cup, a reusable fork as well as a bag to carry the dirty dishes home. In addition to pancakes, turkey sausages and juice will also be available for all of the kids.

Lastly, come January, we will be asking staff and students to participate in our organic waste recycling program. Please speak to your child(ren) about disposing food scraps properly – at home and in the classroom. Every classroom will have a pail for organic waste available and we are hoping that students will quickly make it a habit to dispose their left over food into the pail. Pails will be emptied once every day. The city will pick up our organic waste once every month.

Let me end this newsletter by wishing all of you a peaceful, relaxing and joyful Christmas season.
