Looking forward to seeing you at our student-led conferences on February 10th & 11th!



Parenting Wisely Course



Parenting Wisely is a free course about managing the behaviour of elementary school children. Topics include waiting patiently until conversations or phone calls are over, morning and bedtime routines, cooperating with friends and peers, behaving in public and schoolwork challenges. Two Parenting Wisely courses are being presented by Stan Simister and Porter Elementary School.

One course starts **Tuesday January 19, 2016, from 9:30am to 11:30am**. This class will run for 7 consecutive Tuesdays and ends on March 1, 2016. A second course starts **Wednesday January 20, 2016, from 9:30am to 11:30am**. This class will run for 7 consecutive Wednesdays and ends on March 2, 2016.

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


