To Parents and Guardians:

The cost of the field trip reflects your child's expenses only. No student will be denied access to a field trip or activity due to an inability to pay. School-Wide Winter Activity Day Information

Date of Field Trip: Tuesday, March 3, 2015

Nature of the Field Trip: This is a fantastic opportunity for the whole school community to participate in our Winter Club Day. Your son or daughter can learn a new winter sport at Mount Seymour and/or enjoy one or more pre-determined activities at a popular local destination. No previous experience is necessary, however students are reminded to choose their activities wisely with their ability levels in mind. Ski and snowboard sessions include a mandatory 2 hour lesson (based on ability) taught by qualified instructors. The school code of conduct applies at all times; any dangerous, inappropriate or irresponsible behaviours exhibited while off school grounds will result in the student being returned to the school at the parent's expense.

Students will need to bring: Warm and layered clothing, waterproof pants and jacket, a toque, gloves, goggles, helmet (skiing/snowboarding) and extra socks. Students should also bring their own snacks, ample fluids, lunch or lunch money. On-mountain storage facilities are available for a fee, but limited, so bring only what is necessary. Teachers will not supervise belongings and are not responsible for items that are damaged, lost or stolen.

Complete form(s) and payment in full due Wed. January 28: By submitting all the required forms & payment, allows students to reserve a spot in their chosen activities. (NOTE: There are a limited number of student spots in each activity – **first come, first served**). Registration starts <u>Wednesday, January 28th</u> in Block D and continues on Thursday, January 29 & Friday, January 30th, in core classes. Registration closes on Wednesday, February 4, 2015. Students who miss the registration deadline will be registered into the low-cost activity at the student's cost.

Students who are not attending Winter Activity Day at Mount Seymour: Parents must complete the section "Parent/Guardian Consent Form for students NOT attending Field Trip" on the attached page. This is due back to the school by <u>Wednesday, February 4, 2015</u> or as circumstances change.

NOTE for skiers AND snowboarders: If your child will be going skiing or snowboarding, they <u>MUST submit a completed</u> mandatory green waiver form with their payment and signed permission slip. Extra copies can be found at the office.

Cancellations/Refunds cannot be guaranteed.
