Success Club – Information for Parents

We are pleased to introduce **SUCCESS CLUB - a Homework Support Club** at Maillard Middle School beginning **Tuesday, February 3rd**. This opportunity will be available **every Tuesday from 3:00–4:00 PM** and is designed to give students a calm, structured environment to complete unfinished assignments or receive additional academic support.

How Students May Attend

Students may participate in the Success Club in two ways:

- **By teacher recommendation**, if staff believe the extra support time would be beneficial.
- **By voluntary drop-in**, if the student chooses to attend on their own initiative.

Attendance & Safety

- Staff will maintain a **sign-in and sign-out** process each week.
- Although the club runs for one hour, students are not required to stay for the full session.
- We ask students to **communicate with parents or guardians** if they plan to attend so families are aware of any changes to after-school routines.

Behaviour Expectations

Success Club is intended to be a quiet, productive workspace. If a student is disruptive or not using the time appropriately, they may be asked to leave for the day.

Our Goal

This program aims to help students stay organized, complete missing work, and feel supported in their learning in a positive, structured environment.
