

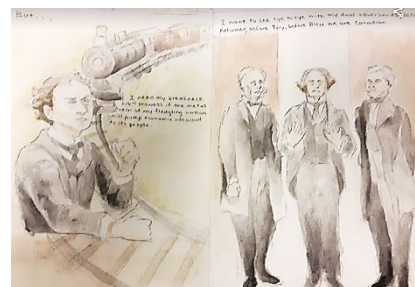
# JUMPSTART

## Continuing your art studies at Gleneagle

The JumpstART program is an excellent option for students who are passionate about art and who may want to specialize in their senior years. Gleneagle Secondary offers a comprehensive visual arts program at all grade levels. Unique to the school is **Artistic Practice 12** for students who are planning to pursue careers in the visual arts.

Gleneagle is the recipient of one of ten Emily Carr University of Art and Design Scholarships. This scholarship reflects the high number of our graduates who gain entrance to ECUAD. Additionally, Gleneagle is the host school for the **Headstart in Art** Emily Carr satellite program, allowing graduating students the opportunity to take additional courses for university credit while still attending secondary school.

Following JumpstART, students can personalize their courses with Art 10, 11, & 12, Drawing and Painting 11 & 12, Artistic Practice 12, Graphic Arts 11 & 12, Animation 11 & 12, Media Design 10 & 11, Photography 10, 11, 12, Ceramics 11 & 12 and Yearbook 10, 11 & 12. Independent Directed Studies is also available to students who have taken all available courses in an area of focus and want to continue to deepen their studies with a mentor teacher.
