- Principal Report Andrew Graham
 - **Welcome** to all the new families coming to Maple Creek in the fall. Thank you to the existing PAC.
 - Covid 19 The school had only had 3 exposures all year and then had 3 in one weekend. Currently two classes have been isolated. The school is seeing more kids getting sick. Staff and parent community have been very supportive. Many steps take place to contact trace and notify the school of the exposure. It is a long process and takes many hours to deal with each exposure. Even with all the layers of protection people can get this virus. The school is hoping for a more normal year next year.
 - Goals First goal is social emotional. Second goal is literacy.
 - **Composition** Number will be down by 45-50 students next year. Staff has gone down from 26 to 24 divisions. The school had 12 teachers laid off. Maple Creek hopes to get some of them back if the positions are not filled in June.
 - **Grade 5** Virtual Orientation this week (Thursday evening) to show how middle school works. Another video will come out in June with current staff and talking about Maple Creek. Maple Creek does lots of things to keep the school connected safely.
