



Speech & Language Drop-In Clinics

Who? Parents who are concerned about their preschool-aged (0-5 years) child's:

- speech sound development
- language skills development
- stuttering
- hearing and/or understanding language

What? Drop in to talk with one of the Health Unit's Speech-Language Pathologists for 5-10 minutes. Your child will receive a brief screening of his or her communication skills. You will receive help for your child's speech and language development.

How? **This clinic is for children who have not yet been referred.** It is best suited to families who are not sure whether a referral is needed.

Clients are seen on the basis of first-come, first-served.

As this is a drop-in clinic, each session is brief (5-10 minutes).
