Programs of Choice and Kindergarten Registration and Cross Catchment:

Grade 5 families, please watch your email for information regarding Late French Immersion registration. I did send some information out through email earlier today.

PROGRAMS OF CHOICE (January 11 – 17, 2024)

Registration must be done through the Programs of Choice online application process located on the SD43 website. **All Programs of Choice online video presentations are located on the District website**.

Early French Immersion, Early Montessori and Mandarin Bilingual programs.

Kindergarten children with **siblings** in a Program of Choice must still apply online and fill in sibling information. **Failure to do so will result in the incoming sibling not getting into the program.**

Late French Immersion, Late Montessori programs.

Children with **siblings** in a Program of Choice must still apply online and fill in sibling information. **Failure to do so will result in the incoming sibling not getting into the program.**

Reggio Influenced Program

Meadowbrook area children entering Kindergarten **should register during online Kindergarten registration directly at the school between February 6-8, 2024**. Non-catchment area children entering Kindergarten (including children with siblings in the program)

should apply through the Programs of Choice online application process between **January 11 at 9:00 am – January 17 at 4:00 pm**.

Registration Process for Children with Special Needs

In the interest of providing a well-defined entry procedure for this very important group of new students, the following is recommended:

- 1. Parents of children with special needs **should register utilizing the online registration form as do all families**.
- 2. Parents should contact the school to inform them of the child's needs.
- 3. Learning Services will develop a list of children potentially in need of special services, based on information from preschools and daycares, parents and community agencies.
- 4. The appropriate school program and support will be determined through discussion with the school, district personnel and the parents.

General Information:

Parents should:

- ensure that any changes to student data, especially address changes, are in the current school's student record system.
- ensure they have the correct information to be listed as their child's "catchment" school by utilizing the school district school locator with their current address which should be the address on file in the student records at the school.
- ensure they have their child's personal education number (PEN) which is required on both the Programs of Choice and the Cross Catchment applications. The PEN number can be located on their child's report card or by accessing their MyEd parent portal.
