# Pam:

- Pizza feedback. Staff very appreciative with fundraising this year. Well oiled machine. The preordering has made everything so much easier. Little Caesars has been very accommodating. Ordering approx. 72 pizzas a time and they are sold out.
- Collab day on Wed 22<sup>nd</sup>. District talk about the school move. The logistics. Labelling etc to make sure boxes goes to the right spot. Staff want to know what they're doing.
- Garage sale idea has been shelved. Not enough to warrant doing it and winter isn't a good time. Crystal and other 2 noon-hour supervisors are packing it all up for Bog Brothers to collect.

- Pizza days are now showing each date so we can track our profit accurately.
- Have a profit of \$1,548 so far this year. Some dilly bars and freezies left so we can do another treat day soon.
- New ordering system for pizza lunches is going very well and as a result sales and profit are up (Nov profit \$239, Jan profit \$381).
- Parent donations stand at \$1,070.
- Final fundraising balance (including carry over from last year) = \$5,858.91.
- We are fundraising for items for the teachers in the new school. Teachers have a budget for items for the news school from the District but because we are a replacement school, we have to use everything salvageable from old school. Therefore, only a small supplemental budget. A

lot is not covered, (i.e. the new mural and center circle in the new gym). Corporate sponsors not well received in public education!
