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the district. Strategic plan priorities: intellectual development, human and social development, developing the educated citizen, organizational capacity. Directions 2025 outlines strategic goals, this is also available on district website.

- MDI: middle years development initiative: implemented in 2009, 75% of districts in province participate. Can compare on school to school level. Links are available in PAC newsletter that was sent out this week.

 to use it by the end of the year, mandate is 1 student, 1 record. There are 2 options to
 login: email and password or BC Services Card (no password expiry). Ministry is actively
